



Family of Taser Death Victim Retains Local Law Firm; Continues Investigation

Grand Rapids, Mich. – Gruel Mills Nims & Pylman LLP, a Grand Rapids, Michigan-based law firm, has been retained by the family of Matthew Bolick, an East Grand Rapids resident, who died November 16, after he was Tasered by two members of the East Grand Rapids Police Department.

The firm is conducting an investigation into the incident and has multiple lines of inquiry to be explored, including the official coroner’s report released December 10, and the fact that there have been more than 330 deaths linked to Taser use by police in the United States, according to Amnesty International.

“This is a time of tragedy for all parties involved,” says William F. Mills, partner with Gruel Mills Nims & Pylman LLP. “While Matt’s family continues to grieve his passing, we will do everything in our power to resolve this issue, ensuring that it never happens again, per the family’s wishes.”

Bolick was a 30-year-old Central Michigan University student studying meteorology, and a respected and honored employee at UPS. He was the oldest of five children.
